Due to the limitation on the number of people present at the meeting, the Mayor read an update from Mr. Don Fontaine, Chairperson/Liaison US Census Bureau, which gave the current statistics for the 2020 census and encouraged the participation of all Kaplan residents.

Mayor Kloesel gave an update on what savings the residents should expect to see with the new SLEMCO contract in effect and explained that the new bills will show the KW and cost comparison from 2019 and current.
